STUDENTS

Student Health

The superintendent will arrange for health services to be provided to all students. Such services shall include but not be limited to:

- A. The maintenance of student health records;
- B. The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill during the school day;
- C. Consulting services of a licensed healthcare provider or registered nurse for staff, students and parents/guardians;
- D. Vision and hearing screening; and
- E. Immunization records and screening.
